Payment and Fee Information

Accepted forms of payment for services are:

- Cash, personal check, most major credit cards
- We accept Medicaid, Medicare, Florida KidCare, AvMed, Blue Cross, United Healthcare, and we also accept the following Medicaid HMOs: Wellcare, Healthese, Sunshine, Clear Health Alliance, Molina, Humana, Staywell, as well as Dentaquest for dental. If you are part an HMO, please verify with your HMO first what provider you are authorized to go to before scheduling an appointment.

Medical Fees: For patients without insurance coverage, or for services not covered by insurance, you may be eligible for reduced fees set on a sliding fee scale based on proof of Indian River County residency and household income.

Dental Fees: Dental services are available to Indian River County residents regardless of age or income. Services are not offered on a sliding fee scale, but are at reduced rates based on Medicaid reimbursement. Medicaid and Dentaquest are accepted. Please verify with your Medicaid HMO what dental provider you are authorized to go to before scheduling an appointment.

Environmental Health Fees: Fees are based on Department of Health and county rates.
