Dear Parent(s) or Legal Guardian(s),

The Florida Department of Health in Indian River County (DOH-Indian River) has been informed of a case of COVID-19 at your child's school. After an investigation, DOH-Indian River is notifying parents of students who were identified as direct contacts to the case. A direct contact is anyone who had face-to-face contact with or was within six feet, for a total of 15 minutes or more, of an infected person.

Please monitor your child for any symptoms of COVID-19. If you notice any symptoms, contact your child's health care provider immediately for further evaluation and testing. If your child exhibits symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19, he or she should stay home from school.

COVID-19 is a respiratory illness spread mainly from person-to-person through respiratory droplets which are produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes or talks. These droplets can land in the mouths and noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs.
